



## Belle-époque Cufflinks

England 1911

### Description

Pair of neo-classical cufflinks in silver and translucent mauve enamel *de baisse-taille*.

British assay mark for silver 925/1000 and city mark for Birmingham.

Date letter "m" for 1911.

### Conditions

Superficial scuffs on the enamel and metal as commensurate with age.

Overall good conditions.

Measurements: 1.9 x 1.0 cm.

Weight: 12.0 g.

### Commentary

Very elegant pair of cufflinks of a delicate colour typically of this epoch. Similar examples might be found in contemporaneous creations by Cartier and Fabergé. The perfect conditions of the enamel with no chips make it a very attractive piece.
