Neo-Classical Cufflinks

*Made for the Russian market
About 1900*

Description

Pair of dome shaped cufflinks in 14 K yellow gold, with laurel leaves and 2 old brilliant cut diamonds for a total weight of about 0,14 ct. Russian assay mark for imported gold 770/1000 (56 Zolotniki with Kokoshniks head), about 1908-1917.

Conditions

Wax cast gold with matt surface then chiseled, pierced and filed down.
Overall very good conditions.

Measurements: 0.8 x 0.8 cm.

Weight: 7.2 g.

Commentary

Of neo-classical inspiration and with matt gold, this pair of cufflinks shows a very attractive Russian look in the same way of Fabergé's works.
