Description

Sophisticated pair of earrings in 14 cts. yellow gold in form of three hoops. American assay mark for gold and signature hand engraved "Ruser".

Conditions

Fresh piece including both Ruser's signature in calligraphic character and American marks, in a very legible way. Overall very good condition.

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Commentary

William Ruser was one of the most important people involved in the revitalization of jewellery in the 1950s. After collaborating with Trabert & Hoeffler-Maouboussin in New York, in 1947 he opened a boutique on Rodeo drive, Hollywood.

Best known for his sculpted gold jewelry featuring freshwater pearls and nature motifs such as birds, poodles and cherubs, he also showed a strong sense of humour.

His fancy jewellery and sophisticated design made him one of the most celebrated jewellers in America. In the vanguard along with Verdura and Seaman Schepps, his pieces were prized by Loretta Young e Joan Crawford.
